

Many parents had questions for teachers at three

way conferences about homework, so I have included the DET guidelines to schools on homework expectations at various year levels.

#### Prep - Grade 4

- should not be seen as a chore
- enables the extension of class work by practising skills or gathering of extra information or materials
- will mainly consist of daily reading to, with, and by parents/carer or older siblings
- will generally not exceed 30 minutes a day or be set on weekends or during holidays Grade 5 & 6
  - should include daily independent reading
  - may extend class work, projects and assignments, essays and research
  - will generally range from 30—45 mins per day

#### Leap into Learning

This is the fourth year of our exciting *Leap in* to *Learning* program where children who are enrolled in prep at Carlton PS for the coming year have a chance to experience school routines and to become familiar with our school setting. During this school readiness program teachers will also talk to parents about how they can help their children to settle well into school. 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
#### **Parent Opinion Survey**
