Research tells us that children are using online devices and therefore at risk of being exposed to inappropriate content, at increasingly younger ages. I know that having your children exposed to inappropriate content on the internet is a very big concern for parents and carers. A newly released, self-paced, online course is now available to support families with these tricky but important conversations about inappropriate online material.

The Parents of Tweens Course guides parents through topics that provide skills to build your child's resilience and resistance to hypersexualized culture and the impacts of pornography. Aimed at parents of kids aged 9 to 12 years old, this course is divided into 5 sections and 13 modules.




