## Hot Chocolate Club

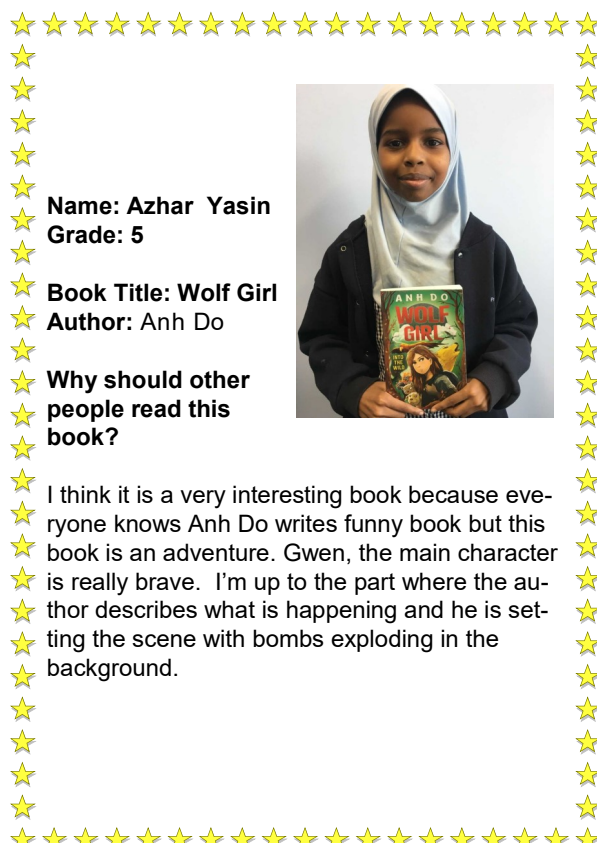
