

Parent and Guardian Opinion Survey

.Every year, the Department of Education asks families for feedback about their children's school. This survey provides schools with important information as we work to continually review and improve our practices. The more families who complete this survey, the more reliable and comprehensive the feedback is to schools. The survey opens this week and will be available to families for a month. It is confidential. It can be accessed online, on computers, smartphones or tablets and takes about fifteen minutes to complete. Survey translations will be available in many community languages. Once the survey becomes "live" we will notify you through Seesaw of how you can access it.

Enrol Now for 2025

As I mentioned in the last newsletter, we are now taking enrolments for next year. Children who turn five years old before April 30th 2025 are able to be enrolled to start school next year. Plans are being made now for our Leap into Learning, school readiness program. This will start later in term three and run into term four. The Leap into Learning program gives incoming preps an extended opportunity to get familiar with school staff and routines and supports them to have a happy and successful transition to school. I will provide more information in future newsletters. To be eligible to attend Leap into Learning, families must have completed an enrolment form for 2025. This can be done online through the link on our website, or you can come to the office to obtain a hard copy.
