### A visit from the Australian treasurer



Recently Carlton Learning Precinct was the venue chosen by treasurer, Jim Chalmers, to launch a new federal government initiative called "Place". This initiative will use federal funds and philanthropic money to address systemic disadvantage. As the treasurer said "Too many kids are trapped in the cycle of generational disadvantage" The new placebased approach involves the partnering of governments and communities to develop long term and collaborative solutions to social issues, tailored to each individual communities' needs. This is work that Carlton Primary has been doing for many years and which has been further expanded since the partnership with Our Place in 2020. Th reason that Carlton Learning Precinct was chosen for the launch is that it is such an excellent example of a "one stop shop" with multiple organisations co-located and working in partnership to support families to thrive.
