Supervision

Families are reminded that teachers are on duty before school from 8.45-9.00am and after school from 3.15 until 3.30pm. Children should not be unattended in the school grounds before or after these times.

Supervision after school & use of school grounds

Over recent weeks we have unfortunately had a number of incidents where children from our school have been unsupervised after school finishes and into the early hours of the evening. In some cases staff or members of the public, have reported seeing children engaging in unsafe behaviours. We have had to make a number of calls to parents and carers about this.

I want to remind families of the duty of care arrangements that are in place to ensure that your children are safe at the end of the day. Staff are on yard duty at the from dismissal time, 3.15pm, until 3.30pm. Supervision after 3.30pm is the responsibility of families. If you are running late and cannot collect your child by 3.30pm, please contact the office and we will bring your children inside to wait and be supervised until you are able to collect them. Can I suggest that all parents have the school number 9347 6022, in their phones. Also, if families need an adult from another family to collect their child, this must be relayed to the school office before 3.15pm.

At 3.30pm, children can only remain on school grounds if they are actively supervised by parents or carers. People from outside the school community, including older siblings and students from other schools are not permitted on school grounds before 6pm, which is when our after care program finishes. These rules are common in all schools and are in place for everyone's safety.

We are very proud of our fabulous school grounds. Our children, unlike children in many inner city schools, enjoy more than a hectare of sports grounds, bushland and play equipment. Unlike many schools, we don't lock our gates after hours or on weekends. We encourage community use of our oval, basketball court and playgrounds, as long as people are using them safely and respectfully and with children being supervised at all times.

Thank you to those families who always actively supervise their children. Let's continue to work together so that everyone can enjoy the school grounds safely.
